The Information We Collect:

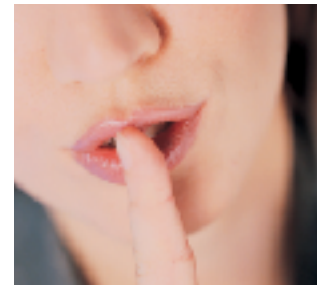
This Policy applies to all information collected or submitted on all PsycTech, Ltd. websites. We use non-identifying and aggregate information for program evaluation and to better design our products.
